SailMaine can host six Varsity HS sailing teams (in addition to the USM Sailing team). In order to provide the following, **every team must** officially **sign up** to be a part of **each** HS Sailing Season.

To apply for a slot for your team, please read and submit this document. It **must be initialed and signed in the places indicated** by your school's Athletic Director and your team's Parent Coordinator and returned to SailMaine. For fall 2010, the deadline is August 5th.

SailMaine will provide the team (at minimum):

- Practice three days a week
- Full regatta schedule (designed with team's ability in mind)
- 420s
 1. Six boats
 2. General maintenance is kept up by SailMaine on boats
 3. Sailors are *also* expected to help maintain boats -- SailMaine presently provides all necessary parts and tools to aide in this upkeep.
- Two team coaches
 1. Each coach is hired part-time which means they attend a minimum of 2 practices a week. _____ (*Athletic Director initials*)
 2. Team members will always be coached by a SailMaine coach and will often not be coached by their team specific coach. _____ (*Athletic Director initials*)
 3. Each coach will travel to 2 away regattas and 3 home regattas.
 4. There are some regattas the team will attend without a coach. _____ (*Athletic Director initials*)
 5. Each Coach is hired and trained by SailMaine.
 6. Each Coach will have access to and use of motorboats, marks, sailing equipment, sailboats, etc.

Basic Requirements:

1. Each team must have:
 - A **minimum of six (6)** sailors signed up for the Fall season by August 5, 2010 at 5:00 PM.
 - A team roster with a **maximum of 16** sailors (15 sailors is ideal).(continued, next page)



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2. Each school will have a meeting between the Head Coach, the SailMaine High School Program Director, and the school Athletic Director to decide how to create the team roster.
 - o SailMaine has a cut policy which teams are free to adopt if it is suitable as is, or to modify to satisfy their school's requirements (see cut policy document). SM's cut policy will govern cuts for SMHS.
 - o Tryouts (if necessary) will take place during the first week of on-the-water practice.

3. Each school is responsible for collecting all registration forms and fees.
 - o Registration forms are due at your first team meeting. Parent Coordinators or the head coach will collect forms and payment.
 - o Registration fee is \$500
 - o Acceptable forms of payment include:
 - o Check made payable to "SailMaine."
 - o Credit card, via phone, or in person at the office
 - o Online payment via Google Checkout (on website)
 - o Submitting a completed Fee Waiver application
 - o Fee Waivers are available for any sailor on any team, and should be mailed directly to Jeff Cumming at SM (see website FMI).
 - o Use of a Payment Plan is acceptable:
 - o 1st payment (half the fee) is due by August 5th, 2010, 5 pm
 - o 2nd payment (2nd half of fee) is due on October 1st, 2010
 - o A package of above items for a minimum of eight (8) sailors must be delivered to SailMaine by August 5th @ 5pm to ensure a spot at SailMaine for the 2010 Fall Season.
